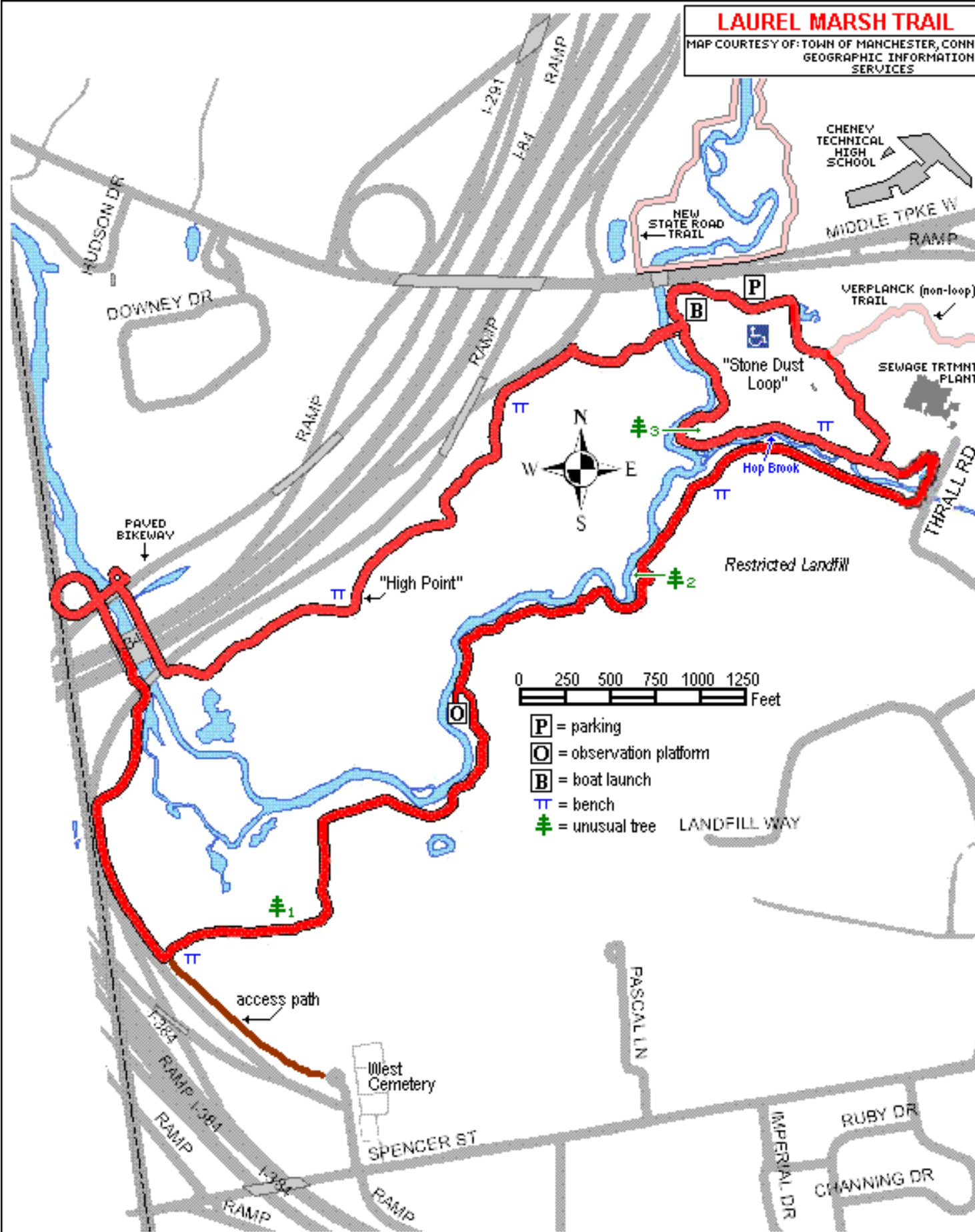


LAUREL MARSH TRAIL

Note: Click within the area bordered by a nearby trail (in pink) to jump directly to it.

- ♣₁ Yellow Birch, *Betula lutea*, close to the trail behind the West Cemetery. Our largest birch.
- ♣₂ Ash Leaved Maple ("box elder"), *Acer negundo*, probably the largest and most multitemed elder on our river trail system.
- ♣₃ White Ash, *Fraxinus americana*, about 30" diameter, fell over. The main trunk is on the ground. The top was lost around 1960, and 7 branches then became vertical as main trunks, which are all now between 10" and 20" in diameter.
